In continuation with the letter at reference and various meetings we had with, it is very disheartening that even the Rule-8 requests of GATE JTOs based on medical grounds are in-ordinately delayed for processing. It was assured that as these executives will be relieved from Kerala Circle to their native places after Membership Verification Process. But it is learnt that, now the requests of these executives are sent back to BAs for verification of their medical grounds. This procedure is not found fair since the requests were submitted through proper channel well in advance and further delay in processing of these Rule-8 requests is not acceptable. Hence, we humbly request you to issue the orders of these executives by this month itself.

We further request your kind attention and speedy redressal for remaining Rule-8 requests of the executives pending for clearance. All these executives have already completed their mandatory 5 years of service in the circle. It may be kindly noted that many executives have already joined in this Circle upon Rule-8 transfers from circles like Tamil Nadu and on completion of JE to JTO LICE training recently.

In light of the above, I earnestly request your esteemed intervention in expediting the processing of Rule 8 transfer requests for the Gate JTOs. The delay in relieving may increase the chances of churn out and resignation from BSNL, thus leading to the drain of young and efficient executives.

Hence, your timely attention and action in this matter would go a long way in addressing the aspirations of these dedicated professionals providing justice to the humanitarian consideration by allowing them to be also with their needy family. Thus we humbly request to process all Rule-8 transfer requests of these executives so as to relive the remaining executives at the earliest.
